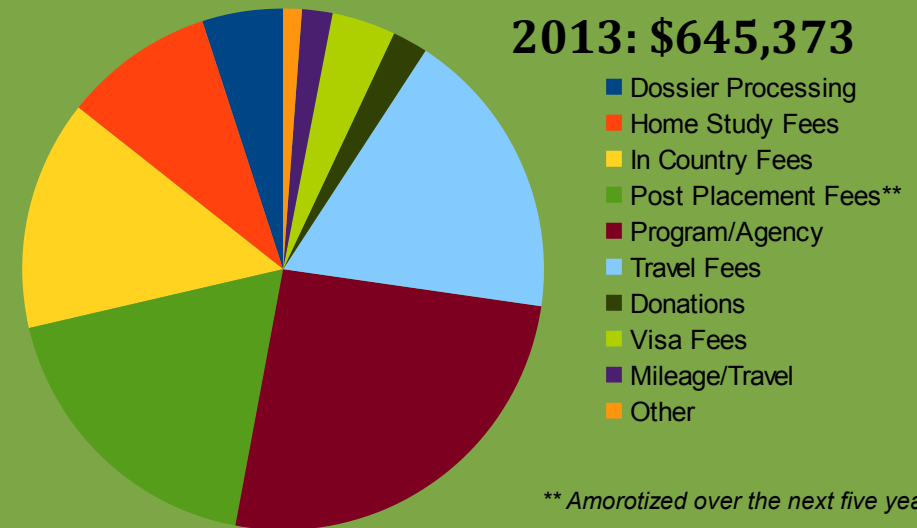
# This Year's Agency Highlights

- Annual Agape Adoptions summer picnic and raffle attended by many families!



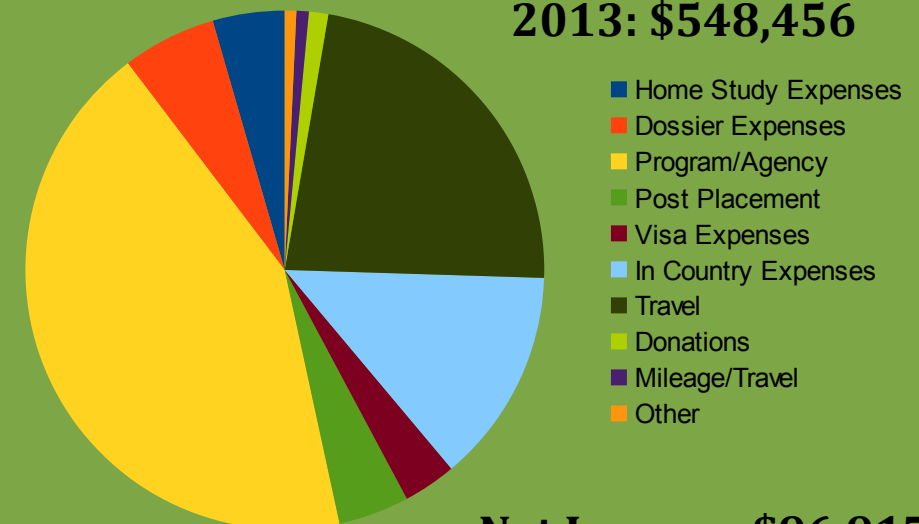
## Income
